I live in the Thornhill area and am an extremely concerned citizen.

Please register my objection to the proposed development plans at the Yonge & Steeles neighbourhood for a number of important reasons.

1. The proposed density is between double and triple that allowed in the Secondary Plan
2. The proposed height is more than double what is currently allowed in the Secondary Plan
3. There has been no consultation with the community
4. The proposals do not enhance the existing neighbourhood. In fact, the existing infrastructure cannot support this large an increase in population. I am concerned about the amount of congestion this will cause and the significant impact on the local schools and community facilities, including parks, waterparks, libraries, community centres.
