## 1. WARD 4 CIVIC HERO AWARD 2020

### Member's Resolution

Submitted by Councillor Yeung Racco:

*Whereas,* City of Vaughan Council has established the Civic Hero Award as a means of honouring citizens who have taken exemplary action in carrying out their responsibility as a citizen under the City of Vaughan Declaration of Citizens' Rights and Responsibilities; and

*Whereas,* the Civic Hero Award has been established such that each Ward Councillor has the authority to execute one nomination in their respective ward per year; and

*Whereas*, Chris Ainsworth is a Ward 4 resident that exemplifies leadership, volunteerism and compassion through the work he undertakes in the community;

#### It is therefore recommended:

- 1. That Chris Ainsworth be named Ward 4 Civic Hero for 2020; and
- 2. That the award be presented at a future Committee of the Whole, Committee of the Whole (Public Hearing) or Council meeting, at a date to be arranged by appropriate staff in consultation with the award recipient.
