To assist the City in finding **new and innovative** ways to manage and make its **transportation systems** more **sustainable** amid the rapidly changing landscape of Vaughan.


Proposed Topics

2. Determine outcomes – what will it look like when the problem is solved?
3. Identify solutions to solve the problem
4. Evaluate solutions based on their ability to accomplish outcomes
5. Recommend solutions to Council
