BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 163-2020

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan to repeal City Boulevards By-law 202-2006, as amended.

WHEREAS section 8(1) of *the Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly as to confer broad authority on a municipality to (a) enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate, and (b) enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS section 11(2)5. of *the Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provides that an over-tier municipality may pass By-laws for the economic, social and environmental well-being of the City;

AND WHEREAS section 11(2)6. of *the Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provides that a lower-tier municipality may pass By-laws for the health, safety and well-being of persons;

AND WHEREAS the Dumping By-law 103-2020, as amended, sets requirements for all long grass and weeds, including boulevards, within the City of Vaughan;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That City Boulevards By-law 202-2006 be repealed.
