BY-LAW NUMBER 167-2020

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan to amend Fence By-law 80-90, as amended.

WHEREAS section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001,* S.O. 2001, c.25 provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate, and to enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS paragraph 7 of subsection 11(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001,

c.25 provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting structures, including fences and signs;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan has enacted the By-law 80-90 to regulate fences within the boundaries of the City of Vaughan;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan has determined that it is desirable to make amendments to By-law 80-90, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Fence By-law 80-90, be amended as follows:
 - (a) Adding section 3.5(j) to read as follows:
 - (j) Notwithstanding any provisions of this by-law, *Fences* that *Encroach* onto the *Boulevard* are subject to the same fence height exemption application process provided under Part 3.5.
