Current Context



Growth Trends in the VMC

- The VMC Secondary Plan established a population target of **25,000** residents and **11,500** jobs by **2031**, with a maximum population of approximately **50,000** residents at full build-out.
- Actual growth is far exceeding these targets.



Growth Trends in the VMC

- Based on development applications received to date, the 2031 residential population is projected to be about 63,000 people.
- If this trend continues across the VMC's neighbourhoods without adjustment, the population at full build-out may be almost twice that number.
- In order to assess current and future levels of service and infrastructure, the new VMC studies and updates need to use a projected population of about 123,000 people at full build-out (netting out employment areas), based on development trends.



It is important to assess how these **current trends and developments** are responding to the City's stated **planning goals.**

Future Vision





As the average density of projects continues to increase steadily with new applications, an important factor that must be **balanced** is the measured delivery of suitable **services** and **infrastructure**.

- Update existing policies, schedules, maps to reflect significant change



VMC Transportation Master Plan from Q4 2020 to Q1 2022

- Support the VMC Secondary Plan Update and provide direction on updating and improving the multi-modal transportation network in the VMC area
- Confirm transportation needs, supportive policies and a phasing strategy to 2041
 - City's Official Plan Review, and updates to the Zoning Bylaw and City-Wide Transportation Master Plan (Vaughan Transportation Plan)



VMC Transportation Master Plan from Q4 2020 to Q1 2022

- Schedule 'C' Class Environmental Assessment Studies for the Extensions of Interchange Way and Millway Avenue
 - Planning and design of the previously proposed extensions of Millway Avenue (from Highway 7 to Interchange Way) and Interchange Way (from Commerce Street to Creditstone Road)







Age Friendly Community Action Plan Background

- Ontario Age-friendly designation is a recognition of a community that has implemented an Age-friendly Action Plan.
- 82 communities in Ontario are provincially recognized as an Agefriendly.
- Age-friendly designation is not just about older adults but has benefits for all members of the community.
- World Health Organization also recognizes and designates communities as Age-friendly. More involved application and recognition process.



Age Friendly Community Action Plan Designation – World Health Organization (WHO)

World Health Organization (WHO) 8 Dimensions of Age-Friendly Communities	Examples
Outdoor Space & Buildings	Safe & accessible public buildings/spaces. Removing barriers that limit social and physical opportunities. Can public spaces be navigated with ease and dignity (sidewalks, trails, buildings, etc.)? Additional supports required?
Transportation	Accessible signage, transportation-related infrastructure, (lighting, sidewalks), public transit. Can older adults go/get to where they want/need to safely, affordably, and without the support of family or friends?
Housing	Ability to age in place, access to affordable housing Are suitable housing options available that fit functional abilities (may change)
Social Participation	Opportunities to interact with the community Are there opportunities to have meaningful connections with others?





Age Friendly Community Action Plan Designation – World Health Organization (WHO)

World Health Organization (WHO) 8 Dimensions of Age-Friendly Communities	Examples
Respect & Social Inclusion	Removal of negative attitudes, intergenerational understanding. What new measures can/will be introduced to better accommodate the needs and diversity that exists in the older adult community?
Civic Participation & Employment	Opportunities to be involved in community life, volunteer opportunities, opportunities to remain employed. Are employment and volunteer opportunities available that match interest and abilities. Opportunities to participate in decision-making?
Community & Information	Information to community events and resources. Ability to reach diverse cultures. Is there an awareness of the programs/services available?
Community Support & Health Services	Access to services that promotes healthy behaviours and life choices including recreation opportunities. Are the required health/social services available to stay active and independent?

Age Friendly Community Action Plan Update on our Process

- Project will be broken up into 5 stages
 - Initiating and Framing
 - 2. Current State Analysis
 - 3. Community Consultation and Engagement
 - 4. Developing the Action Plan
 - Creation of Implementation Plan and Key Performance Indicators

- Anticipated to take 12 months to complete
- Award and project kick-off Jan. 2021
- Detailed project schedule
- Completion Feb. 2022
