## **BY-LAW NUMBER 018-2021**

A By-law to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Regional Municipality of York to allow for the establishment of a mass immunization site and to authorize the City Manager and the Deputy City Manager of Community Services to sign future Memorandum of Understanding with the Regional Municipality of York for additional mass immunization locations at mutually agreed upon City facilities.

**WHEREAS** both the City of Vaughan and the Regional Municipality of York have declared an emergency to manage their responses to the global COVID-19 pandemic;

**AND WHEREAS** the Government of Canada has approved two vaccines to date to aid in protecting the health and well-being of citizens;

**AND WHEREAS** Public Health Units have been tasked with developing mass immunization plans that require the assistance of municipalities to provide locations and supporting services to establish mass immunizations locations;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- THAT the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a mass immunization Memorandum of Understanding with the Regional Municipality of York for the proposed vaccine clinic at the Maple Community Centre, in a form satisfactory to Legal Services.
- 2. THAT the City Manager and the Deputy City Manager of Community Services are hereby authorized to execute future Memorandum of Understanding with the Regional Municipality of York for additional clinic locations at mutually agreed upon City facilities in substantially the same form as the Memorandum of Understanding between The Corporation of the City of Vaughan and the Regional Municipality of York for the vaccine clinic at the Maple Community Centre, and in a form satisfactory to Legal Services.
