

#### What is a Regional Official Plan?


- Long range plan that describes how York Region plans to accommodate future growth
- It provides directions and policies that guide economic, environmental and community planning decisions
- Update of the Regional Official Plan follows Planning Act and Provincial conformity requirements and updates



#### **Updating Growth Forecast**

 York Region's population is expected to grow from 1.2 million in 2020 to 2.02 million residents in 2051

 York Region's employment is expected to grow from 655,000 in 2019 to 990,000 jobs in 2051



This growth forecast informs where and how we grow in York Region
