Hi Christine,

Please amend forestry comments/conditions as follows:

Forestry's Condition:

- 1) As of April 6 2021 this applicant/owner have removed approximately 10 trees (4 of which were owned by the City) which is in direct contravention to the City of Vaughan Private Tree By-law #052-2018. These trees were present at the time of initial inspection (March 12 2021) for this file. This matter has been referred to the By-law and Licensing Department for investigation. The City will require compensation for the City owned trees that were removed. **Forestry recommends this file is adjourned until this matter is concluded.**
- 2) Applicant/owner shall provide an Arborist Report covering the whole property and obtain a "Private Property Tree Removal & Protection" permit (for the remaining trees) through the forestry division prior to building permit approval.

Forestry's Comments:

- 1) Prior to permit issuance, Forestry staff shall inspect and approve the tree protection (hoarding). Tree protection shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Forestry division.
- 2) Tree protection & preservation methods must be followed according to City of Vaughan By-law 052-2018.
- 3) Arborist recommendations are to be followed as outlined in the Arborist Report.
- 4) Forestry will only accept cash-in-lieu tree replacement compensation for any proposed removals.
