BY-LAW NUMBER 054-2021

A By-law to Stop Up and Close a portion of the unopened Mullen Drive Extension as a public highway.

WHEREAS at its meeting of March 10, 2021, Council directed staff to commence procedures, as required by the *Municipal Act, 2001*, to stop up and close the portion of the unopened Mullen Drive extension, located on the north side of the McMorran Crescent and Tansley Road intersection, and in the southwest quadrant of Bathurst Street and Clark Avenue.

WHEREAS notice of intention of the City of Vaughan to pass this by-law was published on the City's website on March 29, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS
AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the lands which are situate in the City of Vaughan, Regional Municipality of York, being the portion of the unopened Mullen Drive extension located on the north side of the McMorran Crescent and Tansley Road intersection, and in the southwest quadrant of Bathurst Street and Clark Avenue be and is hereby stopped up and closed as public highway.
