Purpose: Relief from By-law 1-88, as amended, is being requested to permit the existing deck

and shed located in the rear yard. The shed has been constructed on top of the

existing deck.

The following variances are being requested from By-Law 1-88, as amended, to accommodate the above proposal:

	By-law Requirement	Proposal
1.	A maximum rear yard encroachment of 1.8 metres is permitted for the deck, into the required rear yard setback of 7.5 metres; therefore, a minimum rear yard setback of 5.7 metres is required to an open and unenclosed deck.	To permit a maximum rear yard encroachment of 4.77 metres for the deck; therefore permitting a minimum rear yard setback of 2.73 metres to the deck.
2.	A minimum interior side yard setback of 0.60 metres is required to the accessory building (shed).	To permit a minimum interior side yard setback of 0.40 metres to the accessory building (shed).
3.	A maximum building height of 2.5 metres is required to an accessory building (shed) measured from the average finished grade to the highest part of the roof.	3. To permit a maximum building height of 2.58 metres for the accessory building (shed), measured from average finished grade to the highest part of the roof.

Applicant has advised that they cannot comply with By-law for the following reason(s): At the time of acquisition in 2012, the dwelling had an existing upper deck. In 2019 when the lower deck was constructed, the upper deck was replaced. The replaced upper deck was constructed for consistency, with the same original measurements. the lower deck is extended for use of the rear yard. due to neighbours altering the landscaping in their rear yards, water doesn't run off the property as it used to. (e.g., north neighbour has eliminated all their soft landscaping) water settles in our the rear yard along with the excrements from their dog), making it difficult for use and enjoyment. As a result of the extension of the lower deck, it encroaches the rear yard setback.

Adjournment Request: Applicant submitted a revised proposal and zoning waiver to address planning comments, updating variances number 2 (from 0.19m to 0.40m) and 3 (from 2.92m to 2.58m).

Building Standards (Zoning Review):

Stop Work Order(s) and Order(s) to Comply: Order No. 19-000104, Order to Comply for Construction of a deck located in the rear yard has been undertaken prior to obtaining the required building permit., Issue Date: Jul 15, 2019,

Building Permit No. 19-001692 for Block Townhouse - (Not Yet Issued)

The applicant shall be advised that additional variances may be required upon review of detailed drawing for building permit/site plan approval.

An A/C unit shall be setback a minimum of 0.6 metres from the interior side lot line; and may encroach a maximum of 1.5 metres into the required rear yard of 7.5 metres.

Development Planning:

Vaughan Official Plan 2010 (VOP 2010): "Low-Rise Residential"

The Owners are requesting permission to maintain an elevated deck and accessory structure (shed) with the above noted variances.

In discussion with the Owner, the Development Planning Department recommended improvements be made to ensure the proposal remains in line with the Zoning By-law. The Owner revised their application by reducing the maximum building height from 2.96m to 2.58 m and increasing the interior side yard setback from 0.19m to 0.40 m.

The Development Planning Department has no objection to the variances, as it represents an overall improvement and is appropriate for the development of the lot. Development Planning staff is of the opinion the reduction in rear yard setback to the deck is offset by the 2.73 m strip of soft landscape along the rear lot line. In respects to the interior side yard setback of 0.40 m to a shed, Development Engineering has confirmed the existing shed will not pose any water filtration and drainage issues since it sits on top of an elevated deck. An example where Committee has considered and approved an interior yard setback below the minimum setback of 0.60 m is for a property municipally located at 40 Dalcairney Road (A063/20, permitted a 0.35 m to an existing shed). With respects to a maximum height of 2.58 m, the increase is minor and will not cause a negative impact onto the abutting neighbours.

The Development Planning Department is of the opinion that the proposal is minor in nature, maintains the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law, and is desirable for the appropriate development of the land.

The Development Planning Department recommends approval of the application.

Development Engineering:

Although the typical required setback of a shed from the property line is 0.6m, this shed is located in an elevated deck and not obstructing drainage flow, therefore, the Development Engineering (DE) Department does not object to variance application A037/21.

Please note, that architectural design features (i.e. window placement), that do not impact the style of roof approved by the Committee, are not regulated by this decision.

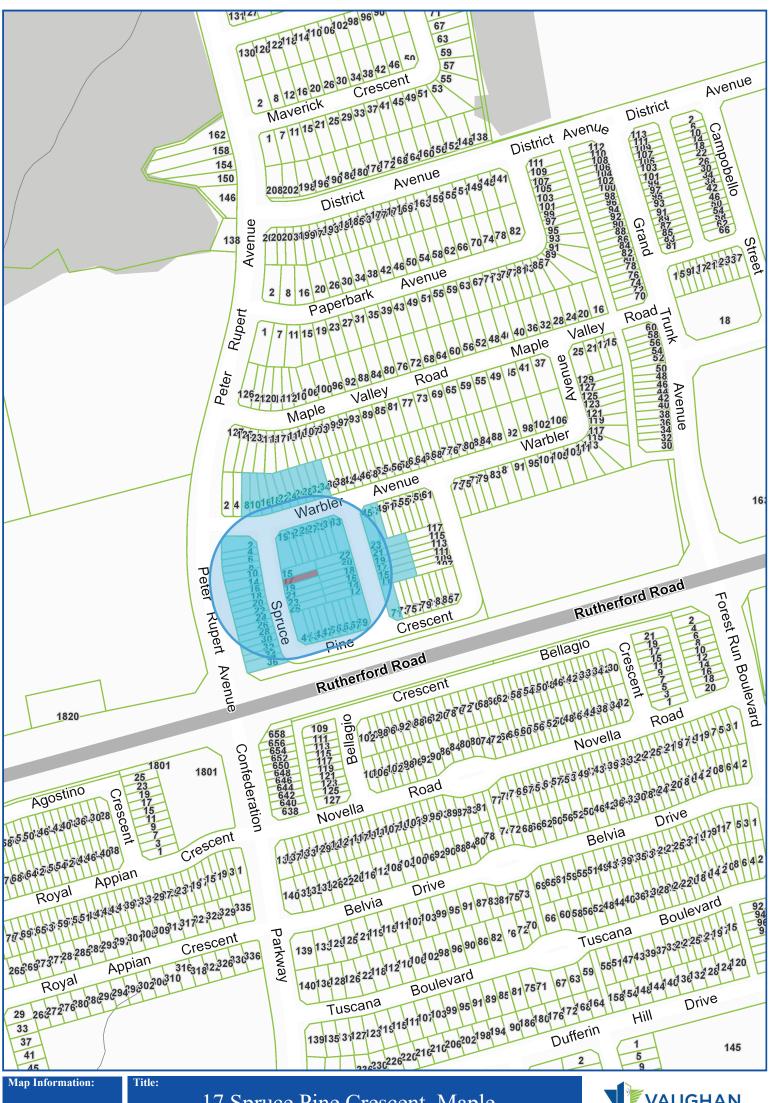

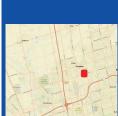

Location Map Plans & Sketches





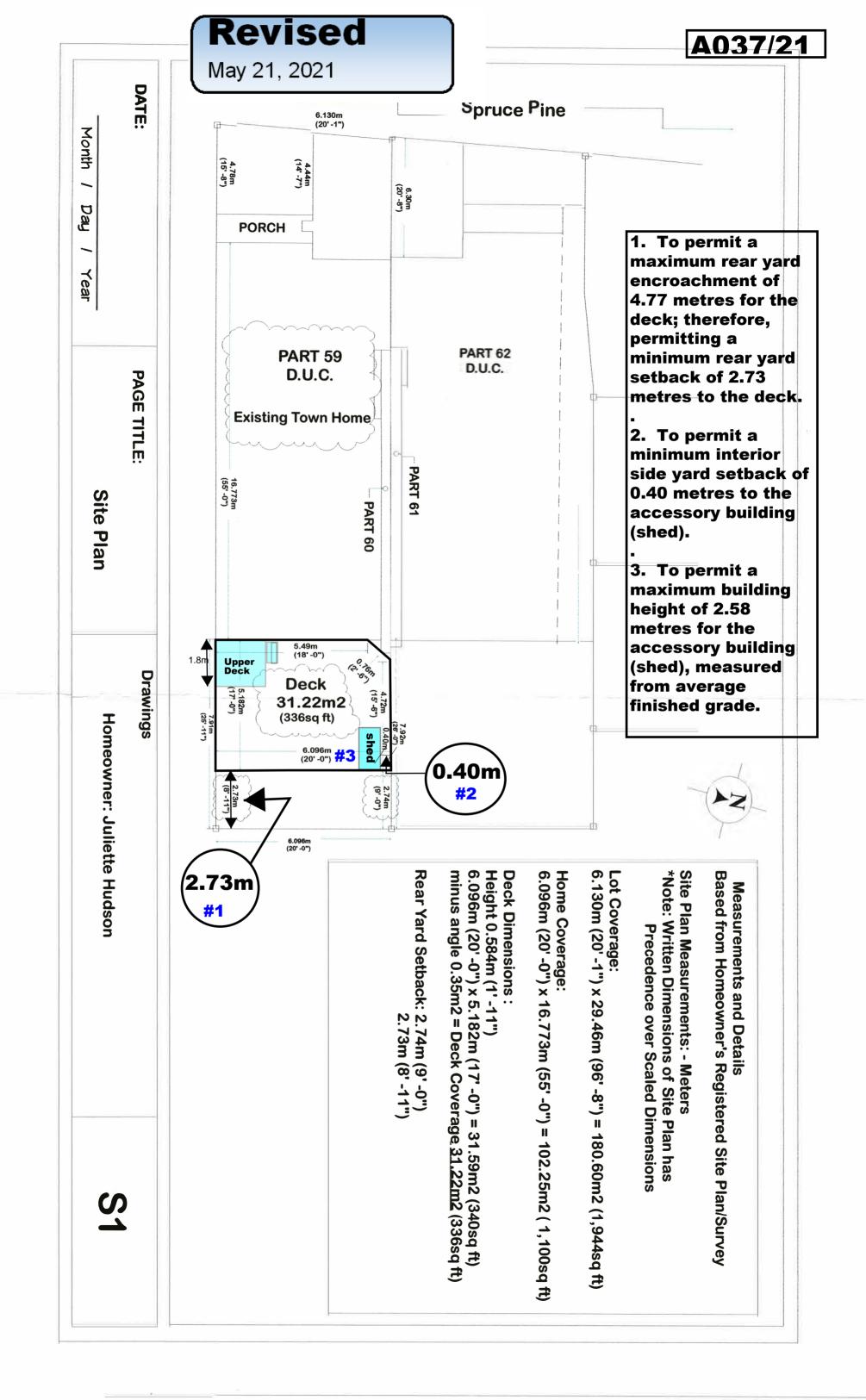
