# *BY-LAW*

## BY-LAW NUMBER 074-2021

**A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan to amend Fence By-law 189-2020, as amended.**

**WHEREAS** section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate, and to enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** paragraph 7 of subsection 11(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting structures, including fences and signs;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan wishes to ensure the transparency of its by-laws through clarity of language and accuracy of references;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Fence By-law 189-2020 be amended as follows:
  - (a) Renumber the second section 17.0 to 18.0 and renumber all the subsequent sections accordingly;
  - (b) In the renumbered section 18.0, change the reference made to 17.0(1) to 18.0(1); and
  - (c) Repeal the renumbered section 22.0(1) and replace it with the following:
    - (1) Fence By-law No. 80-90, and its amending by-laws, 240-99, 162-2004, 203-2006, 208-2007, 29-2014, 167-2020 and any of their amending by-laws, are hereby repealed.
2. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date it is enacted.
