BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 149-2020

A By-law to amend By-law 123-2013, the City of Vaughan's Site Plan Control By-law, as amended by By-law 095-2020, to continue to exempt temporary outdoor patios accessory to Eating Establishments and Banquet Halls from Site Plan Control.

WHEREAS Subsection 41(2) of the Planning Act authorizes Council to enact a By-law to establish a Site Plan Control Area;

AND WHEREAS the whole of the City of Vaughan has been designated a Site Plan Control Area pursuant to Subsection 41(2) of the Planning Act;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to make amendments to By-law 123-2013 as amended by By-law 095-2020 to continue to exempt temporary outdoor patios accessory to Eating Establishments and Banquet Halls from Site Plan Control;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Vaughan considers it desirable to continue to provide specific regulatory relief to "Eating Establishments", "Eating Establishment, Convenience", "Eating Establishment, Convenience with Drive-Through", "Eating Establishment, Take-Out" and "Banquet Halls" to respond to the ongoing economic challenges posed by the COVID-19 emergency measures;

AND WHEREAS it is appropriate to adopt by by-law classes of development that may be undertaken without the approval of plans and drawings otherwise required under Subsections 41(4) or (5) of the Planning Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That City of Vaughan By-law 123-2013, as amended by By-law 095-2020 is hereby amended as follows:

(a) That the following be added to Section 5(b):

"This temporary exemption will not exceed 14 days beyond the date that the City terminates its declaration of emergency, declared to exist in all or part of the City, made under section 4 of the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*;"
