## RE: CITY OF VAUGHAN COUNCIL - ITEM 4.9 - CITY-WIDE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BY-LAW

BILD and our York Chapter Members are in receipt of Item 4.9 - City-wide Comprehensive Zoning By-law the Corporation of the City of Vaughan (referred) as listed on the October 20<sup>th</sup> Council agenda. On behalf of our York Chapter members, we would like to take this opportunity to provide the following sentiments to the members of Council in advance of further consideration.

To begin, we understand that this by-law was deferred from the June 8<sup>th</sup> Committee of the Whole to October 13<sup>th</sup> in order for City staff to address all site-specific concerns of landowners. Though in-between this time-frame there has been limited engagement with our industry on this item, even though we have established a successful industry forum for consultation through the City's Developer Liaison Committee (DLC).

Further to this, our members were not provided sufficient notice that this item was to be considered on October 13<sup>th</sup>, and still have concerns that have been left unaddressed by the City.

Being that our members have not been provided the opportunity to have their legal concerns addressed by City Staff, BILD is requesting a 2-4 week deferral of the adoption of the City-wide Comprehensive Zoning By-law, in order to allow for focused industry consultation.

As your community building partners, BILD firmly believes that by deferring the adoption of this by-law, the City will be avoiding an abundance of appeals that will inevitably hinder development in the City of Vaughan.

In the continued spirit of collaboration and transparency, we trust that you will find our request for deferral as an opportunity to implement a successful Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw by November. In the interim, should you have any questions, please contact the undersigned.
