Vaughan Council,

I am opposed to the extensive urban boundary expansion proposed by York Region in the City of Vaughan. I am requesting that the City of Vaughan send comments back to York Region Council expressing these concerns prior to the Oct 21, 2021 York Region Meeting and that the Mayor and Vaughan's Regional Councilors' vocally expressing these concerns during that meeting. It is irresponsible to plan 30 years into the future when the planning horizon is typically only 30 years. There is far too much uncertain in the midst of a climate emergency and global pandemic to plan this far into the future. Vaughan Citizen requires infrastructure improvements in their existing communities so that we will be able to accept density in the future as our population grows.

As highlighted in the attached sprawl will raise our property taxes and by paid for by your existing residents. Supporting the urban boundary expansion as proposed is not in the public interest and I implore you to take action and communicate my concerns back to the Region of York and the Minister of Municipal Housing and Affairs Steve Clark.
