BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 164-2021

A By-law delegating authority to declare a Significant Weather Event.

WHEREAS on May 3, 2018, Ontario Regulation 366/18 came into force, amending Ontario Regulation 239/02 (Minimum Maintenance Standards for Municipal Highways), under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, SO 2001, c 25, providing municipalities with a mechanism to declare a significant weather event;

AND WHEREAS O. Reg. 366/18 permits a municipality to declare a significant weather event when a weather hazard has been identified that poses a significant danger to road users and an alert has been issued by Environment Canada in response to snow accumulation or ice formation on roads, sidewalks and/or bicycle lanes;

AND WHEREAS Council has adopted the City of Vaughan's Policy on Winter Maintenance Significant Weather Event Declaration in alignment with *Municipal Act, 2001* and Ontario Regulation 239/02;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Deputy City Manager of Public Works or his/her designate, be hereby delegated the authority to declare the beginning and end of a Significant Weather Event for purposes of the *Municipal Act, 2001* and Ontario Regulation 239/02 (Minimum Maintenance Standards for Municipal Highways), in accordance with the City's Policy on Winter Maintenance Significant Weather Event Declaration approved by Council on December 10, 2021.
